TRIP FOR YEAR 5 to Juniper Hall

We would like to take the Year 5 children to Juniper Hall Field Study Centre on Thursday 26 January 2023.. This will complete our river topic. <<FIRSTNAME>> will participate in a "Meander and straights" workshop - they will explore the river and take measurements, look at the variation of sediment. After lunch they will be building rafts and compete in a race!

They will be travelling by coach to Juniper Hall and we hope to be back at West Ashtead by 15:30.

<<FIRSTNAME>> should bring their own wellies and waterproofs, in a plastic bag, however, they can be borrowed free of charge from Juniper Hall if required. <<FIRSTNAME>> should wear suitable clothing for the time of year and weather - they will be outside. Shoes with a sensible grip suitable for walking on hilly uneven terrain, should be worn. You may wish to pack a spare pair of trousers/shoes in case they get wet!

<<FIRSTNAME>> will need to bring a healthy morning snack, a packed lunch and their water bottle in a small bag – please remember no nuts, fizzy drinks or sweets. If your child is entitled to a Free School Meal please speak to Mrs Wood in the Office.

We are very grateful to the Friends of West Ashtead (FOWA), who have subsidised this trip for us, but we still need to ask for a voluntary contribution of £14.70 per child.
