



## **PAINSHILL PARK**

We would like to take Robins on a visit to Painshill Park in Cobham on Wednesday 31 October. . Painshill Park is a beautiful historic site with vast grounds to explore and we have provisionally booked for them to take part in a Sensory Walk focussing on the children senses, and a trail.

The group will travel by coach leaving after registration and returning before the end of the school day. Children should wear school uniform however we would suggest they wear trousers, waterproof if possible, and suitable footwear for walking around (eg wellingtons, trainers). The school will provide the children with a packed lunch which will consist of a sandwich, crudites, fruit, a biscuit and a bottle of water.
