RESIDENTIAL TRIP FOR YEAR 4

Thank you for paying the deposit and confirming that your son/daughter will be joining us on the residential trip to Dorchester in April 2022.

This will be a three day trip beginning on Wednesday 27 April and returning on Friday 29 April. It will offer practical, hands-on life skills as well as being, for some, a real step towards independence. We will hold an information meeting nearer the time however a rough itinerary is below:

Wednesday

We will depart school in the morning, and hope to stop at Rockbourne Roman Villa to have a look around and participate in mosaic making. We will make our way from there on to New Barn for arrival around 16:30. We will have a BBQ and campfire before settling the children in for the night.

Thursday

The children will take part in various activities onsite - orienteering, shelter building, problem solving and team-building activities. The day will end with a professional storytelling session before bedtime.

Friday

We will depart New Barn and make our way to Maiden Castle, before heading to Avon Heath Park for lunch. We aim to be back at West Ashtead for 16:00

There will be a cost of £178.00 (less any deposit paid) per child for this trip. We appreciate that some may wish to pay in instalments so we are offering a payment plan of £32 for December, January and February, with any remaining balance due by the end of March 2022. Reminders will be sent at each due date. Alternatively you can pay in full, if you would prefer.

Please note: any monies paid towards this trip are non-refundable, if your child chooses not to attend.
