To complement our study of World War II, we have invited History Off the Page to provide a Homefront '40: Operation Pied Piper Day in the school on Friday 13 January 2023

History Off the Page is a company which provides immersive and practical History, Science and Literature workshops to schools. The workshop, which will take place in the school hall during normal school hours, will give us a feeling of what it was like to be an evacuee in 1940 during World War II.
